



Acupuncture on Bioresonance

According to Chinese way of thinking, diseases occur when there is a sustained disturbance of the body's energy flow, when blockages lead to a surplus of energy in some places and a lack of energy of other places. The purpose of stimulating acupuncture points is to remove the blockages and trigger the energy flow in motion again. As combine between traditional Chinese medicine and western treatment method, the fundamental frequency values to the relevant acupuncture points to be carried over by means of bioresonance. Practical experience has shown that highly sensitive individuals who have experience with acupuncture will "sense the needle" whenever the appropriate fundamental frequency value is being transferred.

There are particular channel points that will always be disturbed when the channel is disturbed. This makes for a convenient analogy with fundamental frequency values in bioresonance. There are also particular frequency namely the major fundamental frequency values, that are inevitably disturbed if there is a disturbance of the organ. The equivalent for the channels are the channel endpoints. They flag up any disturbance along the entire channel and are therefore of special importance. Their frequency values are as below table.


20.10 Applications with the Rayocomp PS 10, PS 1000 polar and the RAH Green Card

As more and more practitioners are using the portable Rayocomp PS 10 for the home treatment of their patients, all of the programs provided by the RAH can also be accessed via a Rayocomp PS 10. For a home treatment, patients rent a Rayocomp PS 10 as well as the RAH and are issued with therapeutic programs that have been devised by their practitioner for the duration of their treatment. One of the advantages is less travel for patients, who no longer have to get to the practice. Another advantage is that treatments can be outsourced, thus freeing capacity at the practice itself. Conducting home treatment has become much easier, especially through the new Rayonex Green Card.


The idea behind the new RAH Green Card is simple. Previously, harmonising programs that had been determined with the Rayocomp PS 1000 polar or Rayocomp PS 10 via the RAH had to be written down or printed out to be available for future use. With the new RAH Green Card system you can now save your compiled program on a special memory card, i.e. the Green Card. This systems allows you, for example, to download programs that have been tested on a Rayocomp PS 1000 polar to an RAH

Green Card, which is then given to the patient for his home therapy with the Rayocomp PS 10. By means of the RAH Green Card, both devices effectively work together hand in hand.

In addition, the RAH Green Card offers a seamless connection between bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt and the RAH. Often, single frequencies from bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt (for example from an individual range value test) are applied in parallel to an RAH program. To better accommodate this approach, the Green Card has been designed in such a way that it is possible to save single frequencies (up to 500 different values) as well as up to 200 different RAH programs on one card. In addition, a special function has been integrated under the main menu of the Rayocomp PS 1000 polar and the Rayocomp PS 10, so that the harmonisation sequence starts automatically as soon as the RAH Green Card is inserted. The single frequencies saved on the RAH Green Card are harmonised first, each for 30 seconds. After that, the RAH programs that are saved on the same card are harmonised. Therefore, home-treatment patients can apply a Green Card created by their therapist by the simple push of a button.
